

# RED WINE/ ROSE

## Chile

**Sol De Chile Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot 2010 (D.O Villa Alegre, Chile)**

\$ 40/ \$ 168

**75% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25% Merlot.**

Has an intense red-violet color. Its aromas remind us of ripe red fruits with hints of menthol and jam. In the mouth it is soft and round with tannins that are sweet and ripe.

**Sol De Chile Carmenere / Cabernet Sauvignon 2010 (D.O Villa Alegre, Chile)**

\$ 168

**75% Carmenere and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon.**

Has a deep ruby/purple color, medium body with a hint of ripe fruit, earthy and toasty vanillin. Its tannins are soft and velvety.

## Argentina

**Santa Ana Reserve Cab 10 (mendoza, Argentina)**

\$ 198

has a deep ruby red colour with violet hues. Blackcurrant and cassis fruit aromas layered with green peppercorns and spicy complexity. Well balanced mouth-filling wine textured with ripe tannins and a full lingering finish.

**Framingham Pinot Noir 2009 (Marlborough, New Zealand)**

Silver-Air New Zealand Wine Awards 2009. Displays oak, spice and plummy fruit convence and help deliver a very pure elegant palate.

## France

**Château Messire AOC Bordeaux 2008 (France)**

\$ 178

**Carbernet Sauvignon/Carbernet Franc/Merlot**

Black intense color. Powerful bouquet of prune. Round attack and harmonious in a mouth with fruity notes.

**Les Terroirs Cabernet Vin de Pays d'Oc 09 (France)**

\$ 188

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine is a lovely limpid, crystalline ruby-red, and reveals delicious aromas of red fruit. Elegant, rounded, velvety and powerful, it has been selected, matured and bottled with the greatest care and attention.

**Marquis de Chasse Bordeaux Rouge AOC 07 (France)**

The aromatic characteristics of the Marquis de Chasse Bordeaux match its arms. Elegant, round, smooth and full-bodied, this wine offers delicious aromas of soft fruits wrapped in sensuality. 2010 Best Everyday Bordeaux

**Cotes du Rhone 2007 (France)**

\$ 288

Reveals a northern Rhone orientation but it is loaded with spice and black fruits and displays a beautiful opulent texture as well as a gorgeous finish with impressive purity.

**Chateau Saint-Michel 2008 (Bordeaux Superieur, France)**

\$ 338

Rich, concentrated and fruit-driven is the main character of this wine. Blended in 90% Melot and 10% Cabernet Franc.

**Sancerre Les Romains Rose 07 (loire, France)**

\$ 380

Onionskin salmon pink colour, wine with light bouquet, hints of fresh flowers, leather and citrus fruit.

**Chateau Sorbey 2006 (Haut-Medoc, France)**

\$ 438

Displays blackberry, dark cherry, cigar wood with medium body. Nice pairing with rib eye steak. Recommend 30 mins to decant.



## WHITE WINE

### Solde Chile Sauvignon Blanc /Chardonnay 2010 (D.O. Villa Alegre, Chile)

Light body, displays lime, green apple and tropic fruit. Provides refreshing aromas.

### The Lyrup Chardonnay 2009 (South Australia)

With aromas of ripe stone fruit, melon and peach around.

This wine is an attractive pale-medium straw with green hues in color.

The palate has great weight with melon and peach flavours with a hint of citrus, vanilla oak, good length and a soft smooth finish. Perfect partner for creamy pasta dishes and roast chicken. Breathe for 15mins before drink.

### Relax Blue / Riesling 2009 (Mosel Valley, Germany)

This fine Riesling wine originates from the Mosel valley with its steep vineyards and offers an extraordinary premium wine quality. Forward fruit and floral aromas of apples and peaches with just a hint of citrus.

The natural acidity gives the wine a perfect balance that is refreshingly crisp.

This wine pairs well with a wide range of food like light salads, poultry, seafood and blue cheese or just on its own.

### Gran Sasso / Pinot Grigio 2010 (Abruzzo, Italy)

Complex, fruit and herbal aromas, hints of oak, vanilla, nutmeg; Fruity, peach grapefruit, lemon-lime and mineral flavours; medium body with roundness and a pleasant mouthfeel, good balance, finish is long, clean, spicy yet delicate.

### Ara Composite Sauv. Blanc 08 (New Zealand)

"The very gentle whole bunch pressing and the very clean juice is somehow more textured."

There's a nicely smoky, schisty note here, a certain sense of richness and depth with passionfruit and elderflower.

Rich and juicy, with a bit of orangey fruit tang, and again a very dry, lemon pithy acidity.

This has real texture that builds on the palate making it a complex, savoury wine with layered depth on the finish.

### Laurenz V. Sophie Singing / Gruner Veltliner 2010 (Kamptal, Austria)

Laurenz V is the only producer to focus entirely on Gruner Veltliner, Austria's No.1 grape variety.

A very attractive fruit bouquet yields apple, peach and citrus aromas along with a typical Veltliner spiciness and a touch of white pepper. The soft and juicy palate is supported by fine acidity. It sings on the palate!

### CHAMPAGNE

#### Edmond Rentz Cremant D'Alsace Brut Prestige Blanc de Blancs (France)

\$ 268

Made by the traditional Champenoise method from Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay, this has aromas of citrus fruit and white flowers. It is dry, noble and elegant

#### Jacquart Brut Mosaïque NV (France)

\$ 468

Persistent trail of fine bubbles with a pale golden yellow color.

A lively wine, with good varietal expression, revealing aromas of white fruit (pear) and fresh, crusty bread.

A fresh, fairly intense palate, well balanced with good length; undertones of ginger bread and fruit aromas.

### SPARKING WINE

#### Amour De Rose Bordeaux NV Sparkling Wine (France)

\$ 238

Light and lively bubbles. Brilliant in appearance. Citrus and golden apples on the nose. It also develops aromas of bread dough with a hint of honey.

### DESSERT WINE

#### Strewn Palatine Hill Vidal Icewine 2005 (Niagara, Canada)

\$ 368

Focused apricot and caramel with a touch of orange rind and tea on the nose. Viscous and rich on the palate with a wonderful acid balance that carries through the long and flavourful finish.

### ROSE

#### Sancerre Les Romains Rose 2007 75CL (France)

\$ 380

A quite pungent, attractive nose of mineral fruit here; a rich character, with almost a touch of honey to it, but it is the mineral elements that are most memorable.

The palate is round, quite soft, but with a good substance.

There is much firmer structure in the midpalate, where although nicely rounded there is a touch of power.
